Workers will be needed on Saturday by 7:00 a.m. to haul and set-up tables for the sale and until approximately 3 p.m. It is not necessary for someone to work all day; 3 or 4 hour shifts are fine. Band and guard kids would be great help setting up in the morning and picking up in the afternoon. For set-up and closing, we need approximately 20 volunteers. During the day 6 or so volunteers would be sufficient.
