OLD/UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

- •501(c)(3) Update paperwork has not been filed with IRS; still in research stage. Philip Beaman with Monroe Shine has been out of the office for six months; returned to office during tax season. Three letters have been sent to the IRS asking for a copy of the Band Booster Determination Letter. May not have to file paperwork if we are already a 501(c)(3). If we do not receive the Determination Letter by the end of June 2017, we have been advised to file paperwork with the IRS.
- •Section Parent meeting was successful. Thank you, Karen Mourcy, for becoming the saxophone section parent. Each section has a few people they need contact information on. Section parents have been asked to forward MyMusicOffice e-mails to their section to ensure e-mails are received.
- •Fundraising for New Uniforms The Fundraising Committee has researched and established a database of over 100 potential corporate donor prospects. Letters signed by Mr. Yankey have been mailed to them, along with the sponsorship materials. They will be following up by phone. If our band families own businesses or have relationships with businesses who may be interested in sponsoring, please contact the Fundraising Committee at donations@floydcentralband.org so businesses may be approached in a consistent manner. \$500 was received from Republic Bank. Money from FC Athletic Department (\$5,000) and discount cards (\$1,700) needs to be transferred into new uniform account. Adopt-A-Uniform form will be sent out soon. Each uniform costs \$400. Committee is using school account to ensure donations are tax deductible. Committee suggested the pep band or jazz band be hired to perform at Christmas parties this year to raise funds.
