OLD/UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

•**Uniform Fundraising** -- \$ [REDACTED] (includes pledges). At the 7th & 8th HHMS band concert in September, one person approached requesting information regarding corporate sponsorship another asked how they could get involved. An 8th grade guard parent donated \$1,000; another 8th grade parent donated \$400. The next phase of the campaign will be to provide letters to kids to mail to family and friends asking for their financial support. If there is 100% band family participation in the fundraising campaign (each family donates all or a part of a uniform), Mr. Yankey, Ben Gutman or Alec Branstetter will agree to some kind of stunt (e.g., being slimed from the director's platform).

NEW BUSINESS:

•**Invitational Recap** – Profit yet to be determined as receipts and invoices are still being submitted. Largest number of volunteers ever at 140. Profit will be less due to (1) potential sponsors said they couldn't contribute because they had already contributed to the uniform fund; and (2) attendance was down due to bigger bands going to a different invitational. We should get the bigger bands next year. Need to start the process of obtaining an invitational sponsor in January or February.

•**Prop Team Assistance** – Need additional crew to move the stage. Uniform parents said they can help once the students are in uniform.

•**Assistant Director Needed** – Dr. Willman and Interim NAFCS Superintendent, Brad Snyder, will be invited to the November Booster meeting in follow-up to Dr. Willman's attendance earlier this year wherein the issue of Mr. Yankey needing an Assistant Director was discussed. Dr. Willman said he could not afford another teacher, however, there were funds to hire an Administrative Assistant. At the next meeting with Dr. Willman and Mr. Snyder, the Boosters need to present data representing our position as to why Mr. Yankey needs an Assistant Director. Mr. Snyder is an orchestra parent so Mr. Yankey thinks this would be the perfect time to address this issue.

•**Band Booster President Nominations** – None were given. Job requirements are listed in the by-laws, which are on the band website at floydcentralband.org under the Band Boosters tab. Two people sharing duties is permitted. Mr. Yankey is available for a private meeting to discuss the duties of the Booster President.

DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Mr. Yankey thanks all those who helped with the home football game performance on October 6 while he was out. It was the only performance he has missed in 37 years. Not our best performance at Fishers but Mr. Yankey isn't discouraged. Individual scores were down. Uniform from second company is being cut.
