OLD/UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

- **Invitational** – NEED VOLUNTEERS! Section leaders have been asked to contact their sections to obtain volunteers. Logistics standpoint is good. Need hospitality food. Program will be sent to printer by end of business on September 13.
- **Student Representatives** – Do not like the Dri-Fit shirts; would prefer cotton. Students thought the senior banners were a gift. They didn't realize the banners have always been paid for by parents. Would like Senior Banners to have graduation year, not show year.
- **Fundraising for New Band Uniforms** -- \$██████ with pledges. \$██████ in pledges not needed until early January. Three grants: (1) Horseshoe Foundation for \$25,000. Should hear something in November; (2) TEGNA Foundation grant from WHAS11 for \$5,000. Mr. Yankey is contact. (3) Walmart grant for \$2,500. Should hear something in 60 to 90 days. The full uniform Mr. Yankey is interested in purchasing is @ \$450-\$500; \$450 x 200 = \$90,000. If we do not raise the full \$90,000 there are ways to cut costs. There are three levels of fundraising: Tier 1 - corporate donations; Tier 2 – Adopt-A-Uniform, which have both been rolled out. The final Tier 3 – Talking to Students. Students will be encouraged to ask friends and family to combine contributions. At fall programs at HHMS, the fundraising committee will address future marching band students and parents.
- **Car Wash** – 25 to 30 students and parents. Great success! Students had fun. Raised a little over \$1,000.

NEW BUSINESS:
