- •Winter Fantasia Thank you to all volunteers! The silent auction ran smoothly. Best participation ever with 45 baskets! Having two iPads with the ability to use credit/debit cards kept payment lines moving quickly. Each basket was tracked by orchestra, band and choir. Total amount: \$10,698 (\$3,341/orchestra, \$2,787/band, \$4,570/choir). Tickets sold out fast. Mr. Yankey will look into software to pick out seats on line (as is done for theater tickets) for Winter Fantasia 2018. Doing a fourth show would be too much on the students. Moving the performance to another venue would be too costly. There is a possibility the freshman will have their own performance, which would create additional seating.
