Please note: dates mentioned are scheduled but could change due to NAFCS Administration changes.

MARCHING BAND KICK-OFF MEETING AND STUDENT REHEARSAL: May 9, 6:00 pm

The kick-off meeting is an opportunity for families to receive information about the upcoming Marching Band season, meet section parents, and receive/complete all necessary forms. Basically to provide as much information as we can for families. This meeting is important to communicate what our volunteer needs are during the marching band season and to prepare to host our annual FC Band Invitational in September. We ask that one adult from each family attend this meeting.

MARCHING BAND FEES

Marching Band Fees are \$675/student. An abbreviated Marching Band Fee Form is attached at the end of this letter. The complete version will be available at the kick-off meeting. This form gives information on pricing for multiple students, early bird fee payment incentive and an option for installment payments.

Reminder, <u>freshmen are required</u> to participate in Marching Band their first year at FC in order to have Band as a scheduled class.

2023 FLOYD CENTRAL MARCHING BAND COMMITMENT FORM

Once again it is time to prepare for the upcoming marching band season. We are planning a very exciting show for next year called "The Essence of Time" and anticipate an excellent group of band and guard students. This letter is to inform you of the schedule of events for the season and to collect the necessary student fees to run our marching band program.

The band fee, along with booster support, helps cover our program and all that it entails: salaries for the band staff for band camp and marching band season, students' uniforms and uniform maintenance, band show T-shirt, transportation, contest entrance fees, and additional expenses that arise during the season.

THE 2023 BAND FEE IS \$675.00

Fee Discount Opportunities:

- Full payment discount: Pay \$650.00 if paid in full by June 9 2023.
- (Cash or check only to qualify online payments through Charms or Paypal are excluded for the discount)
- Multiple student discounts: 2 students in band \$625.00 each, 3 students in band \$600.00 each.
 If paid in full (as part of option 1 above, decrease fees additional \$25/student)
- Financial hardship discounts may be available to students who qualify. You must contact Susan Wagner BEFORE the first payment is due to see if your student qualifies. Swagner1@nafcs.org or 812-542-8504x3518. No student has ever been excluded from participation in the FC Marching Band due to a financial hardship

Required for 2023 season: Full payment or the first \$225 installment must be paid by June 9 to guarantee a student's spot in the marching band line-up.

Our marching band show is designed based upon the exact number of participating band members – this must remain constant for our show success – therefore if a student quits marching band during the season they are required to forfeit concert band participation and will forfeit a minimum of \$200 of band fees depending on the date the student quits.
